Updates on teen court: Teen court was organized 9 plus years ago; 103 cases have been heard since June 2007. There is a 0-16% recidivism rate for cases that have gone through teen court. Teen court is collaboration between Ashland county Circuit court, UW extension and Ashland county Human Services.

Teen court gives juveniles an opportunity to take responsibility for their behaviors. The teen court panel consists of 9-12th grade students “in good standing”. This panel goes through teen court training. Teen court occurs once a month at the courthouse. They meet with the referral and interview them about the incident.

Fine discussion for teen court. The current fine is \$25, other counties charge up to \$75.
