Mick stated that they have done a lot of traffic stops this past month, deer season was good; no hunting accidents or lost hunters. They will be hiring a full time dispatcher as one employee will be leaving. Discussion followed. Motion by Dick Pufall to approve the Sheriff's report as given with a second by Ken Wheeler. Motion carried.

Terry Schemenauer proceeded with the CJC report. Terry updated on the CJC meeting from last month and some recycling that they have done. Terry stated that things are pretty quiet right now. Motion by Dick Pufall, second by Ken Wheeler to approve the CJC report as given. Motion carried.

Terry Perry followed with the HHS report. The driveway into the building has been patched by the City, the BIRT program has ended due to lack of funding. Terry gave handouts to Committee members on neonatal abstinence syndrome (NAS), self-inflicted injury deaths in Ashland County (all handouts are on file with the minutes). Terry also stated that the working with AFD on the toy drive.

Vouchers were reviewed at this time. Motion by Gary Kabasa, second by Dick Pufall to approve vouchers for payment. Motion carried.

The next meeting was scheduled for January 5, 2016 in the County Board Room.
