Regular monthly Highway Committee Meeting was held on July 11th, 2016 at 9:00 AM at the Ashland County Highway Department Conference Room in Highbridge, WI.

- Item 1. Meeting was called to order by Highway Committee Chairman Carl Kubley at 9:01 AM. Members in Attendance: Rick Korpela, Carl Kubley, Jerry Teague and Dick Pufall. Also present: Emmer Shields, Highway Commissioner, and Ken Lindquist, citizen.
- Item 2. Approval of Agenda. Motion to approve agenda by Jerry Teague, 2nd by Rick Korpela. Motion carried.

- Item 4. Ken Lindquist complimented the County Crew for the work completed on CTH C and suggested some safety considerations for the detour.
- Item 5. New and Old Business
- * Flood Damage - Commissioner Shields gave an overview of the recovery to date from the July 11 /12 flood. The Department is continuing to place culverts and repair state, county and town roads and highways. All department staff are engaged in these activities and will continue to do so until further notice.
 - * Request for Marathon - The Department has been contacted by a group, which hopes to hold a Marathon on Madeline Island next spring. The Commissioner will contact them with requirements that must be met before they can receive county approval.
 - * Work Schedule - The Department will be engaged in flood recovery work for the foreseeable future. Long term the Department has a number of PBM projects and a DMA project that need to be completed for the State.
 - * Detour Posting - The STH 13 detour on CTH C has been weight posted. The Commissioner is issuing local trucking concerns permits on a hardship basis only.
