Donna Williamson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Motion by Jerry Teague, seconded by Norm Couture to approve the September 6, 2016 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Kathy Schutte was present today regarding information that she obtained at the WCA meeting. This will be placed on the next agenda in the hopes that there will be a full Committee.

Mick Brennan handed out the Sheriff's report for review. Currently there are 57 inmates, 6 boarded out and 13 on monitor which is up from this time last year. 45% of the jail population is from probation violations. Discussion followed. Mick also talked about filling vacancies and training and 2 possible litigations. Motion by Norm Couture, seconded by Jerry Teague to accept the Sheriff's report as given. Motion carried.

Terry Schemenauer gave an update on the CJC report and discussion followed.

Mark Miller proceeded with the Custodial report. Mark stated that the A/C's will be coming out in the next couple of weeks; they need help to replace a part-time employee that passed away. Mark has been busy wrapping pipes in the attic where the asbestos was removed. Mark is also looking into replacing three (3) light fixtures as they are out of 8' florescent lightbulbs. Also, Mark brought up the age of the lawn mower (16 yrs.) and the snow blower attachment (25 yrs.).

Jim Hnath handed out sheet titled "Amending of Ordinances and Bond Schedule". The paperwork showed the new dollar amounts and a new section 12. Discussion followed. Motion by Jerry Teague seconded by Norm Couture to accept the new bond amounts. Motion carried. Motion by Norm Couture, seconded by Jerry Teague to adopt section 12 as presented. Motion carried.

Pete Russo and Jim Hnath held discussion on possible jail expansion.

Vouchers were reviewed at this time. Motion by Jerry Teague, seconded by Norm Couture to approve vouchers for payment. Motion carried.

The next meeting was scheduled for November 10, 2016 in the County Board Room.

Motion by Jerry Teague to adjourn with a second by Norm Couture. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 10:14 a.m.
