Jail Population Review:

Total jail population – 59, 13 on EMP, 9 boarded in Bayfield County. There are 17 females in jail. 8 in F block, 2 in G block, and 7 in Bayfield County being boarded. The female jail population is up across the entire state.

TAD report:

10 participants – 6 on bail and 4 on DEJ's.

Probation/Parole

Eric introduced himself and stated he will have a report next month.

Adult Drug court report:

7 active participants , this number is down for drug court but because it is at the end of the grant cycle there will not be any new referrals. To date there has been 35 participants, 27 discharged, 15 of the discharges are successful graduations. Drug court has saved 3095 bed days with a savings of approximately \$170,000.
