**Jail Population Review:**

49 incarcerated; 12 females, 37 males, two are housed in Bayfield county.

**TAD report:**

9 participants. There was a TAD meeting with Ray Luick last week. We still have \$22000 treatment dollars unspent this year

**Probation/Parole**

601 total clients in Ashland, Bayfield and Iron counties. There are 86 in prison; 13 will be released in the next 6 months; 5 offenders are currently in revocations status; 8 on holds in the jail. There are 7 agents in the Ashland office with 2 new agents being added in October.

**Adult Drug court report:**

7 active Participants. In October there is training in Trego on Wisconsin Treatment court standards.

**Longrun report:**

4 hours of adult community service completed and 4.5 hours of juvenile community service completed in the last month. We hosted Bayfield counties clean sweep and on August 15<sup>th</sup> we are doing Ashland County's clean sweep. Drop off is at WITC, south parking lot, starting at 9am.

**Truancy:**

Next truancy meeting needs to be set before school begins.

**New Business:**

**FSET** – Delores and Tracy presented information about the FSET (Food Share Employment Training) program. Age requirements are from 18-49 (17 year olds could participate in the workshop. 50 and above can volunteer. This program is in a partnership with CEP.

They are looking for clients and job sites. Some people in food share programs need to mandatorily participate in employment programs. This program includes resume writing, job search help, job shadowing, education, work experience. Their office is in the Enterprise building.

**Homeless Count:** the homeless count is taking place tomorrow in Wisconsin from 10pm until 6am.

**Legislative update:** New 70 mile speed limit on some highways; when a stoplight is not working you can treat it like a stop sign; use of a GPS for stalking is a misdemeanor crime.

**Chequamegon Coalition on emerging drugs:**

The Meth training will take place on October 9<sup>th</sup> at the Bad River Convention Center. Dr. No, Kelly McKnight, and a couple of other trainers will be presenting.
