ORDINANCE NO.

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES OTHER THAN SNOWMOBILES ON ASHLAND COUNTY SNOWMOBILE TRAILS

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Ashland does ordain as follows:

1. No person may drive, operate or park any motor vehicle other than a snowmobile on an Ashland County Snowmobile Trail
2. Motor vehicles which are not permitted on an Ashland County Snowmobile Trail include but are not limited to automobiles, trucks, four-wheel drive vehicles, motor cycles, motor bikes, mopeds and all types of all terrain vehicles including those with three and four wheels.
3. This ordinance may be enforced by the County Sheriff or any other law enforcement officer. This ordinance covers all snowmobile trails which are now or are hereinafter designated to be snowmobile trails by Ashland County. This ordinance is in effect year round. Each provision of this ordinance shall be severable from the remaining provisions.
4. This ordinance is not applicable to motor vehicles which are on an Ashland County Snowmobile Trail for the sole purpose of maintenance.
5. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance is subject to a forfeiture of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus applicable court costs and assessments. Upon the failure of any person to pay the forfeiture and costs and assessments imposed by the court within the time permitted by the court may be imprisoned not to exceed five (5) days. Any person who violates a provision of this ordinance is also responsible for the costs of repairing any and all damage caused by such operation.

Pursuant to Section 59.09(1) Wisconsin Statutes the County Clerk is directed to immediately publish this ordinance as a Class I Notice under Chapter 985 Wisconsin Statutes and to procure and distribute copies of this ordinance to the several town clerks who shall file the same in their respective offices. This ordinance is effective upon its publication. The County Clerk is also directed to forward a copy of this ordinance to the County Sheriff and to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
