

ORDINANCE NO. 07-1999-25

Ashland County, Wisconsin

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HABITUAL TRUANCY

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Ashland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Authority. This ordinance is enacted as per §118.163(2), Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. Habitual Truancy Prohibited. No person between the ages of 6 and 18 shall be a habitual truant.

Section 3. Definition. When used herein, "habitual truant" has the meaning given in §118.16(1)(a), Wisconsin Statutes.


Section 4. Enforcement. After receiving certification that a person is a habitual truant, the Ashland County juvenile intake worker may refer the child to the District Attorney requesting the filing in an appropriate court of an ordinance petition or citation for a violation of this section.

Section 5. Penalty. The court will impose on any person convicted of violating a section of this ordinance, one or more of the penalties set forth in §118.163(2), Wisconsin Statutes. If the person convicted of violating this ordinance is under 17 years of age, that person will also be subject to any penalty authorized by §118.163(4), Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. Citation. The provisions of the Ashland County ordinance authorizing the issuance of citations for certain ordinance violations in Ashland County bearing even date herewith are incorporated herein by reference as a part of this ordinance.

Section 7. Effective. This ordinance is effective the day after its publication. This ordinance shall be immediately published as a Class 1 notice under Chapter 985, Wisconsin Statutes, and the Clerk shall procure and distribute copies of this ordinance to the several Town clerks, who shall file it in their respective offices as per §59.14(1), Wisconsin Statutes.
