

ORDINANCE CONCERNING SYNTHETIC ALTERNATIVE DRUGS

WHEREAS, Ashland County residents have experienced the tragic consequences of the sale and use of synthetic cannabinoids; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers of Ashland County have seen detrimental effects caused by the use of synthetic cannabinoids; and

WHEREAS, the sale of synthetic cannabinoids has been marketed towards children; and

WHEREAS, schools in Ashland County have reported use of synthetic cannabinoids by their students; and

WHEREAS, medical personnel have reported emergencies related to the use of synthetic cannabinoids, and

WHEREAS, 2011 Wisconsin Act 31 amended section 59.54(25g) of Wisconsin Statutes to authorize county governments to enact and enforce an ordinance prohibiting the possession of synthetic cannabinoids, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Ashland County Board of Supervisors, Wisconsin, as follows:

1.01 Definition. As used in this Section, "Synthetic cannabinoid" means any material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains any quantity of any of the following hallucinogenic substances, including any of their salts, isomers, precursors, analogs, esters, ethers, and salts of isomers, esters, or ethers that are theoretically possible within the specific chemical designation, in any form contained in a plant, obtained from a plant, or chemically synthesized:

- (1) Cannabicyclohexonal; 2-[(1R,3S)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl]-5-(2-methylnonan-2-yl) phenol.
- (2) CP47, 497 and homologues: 2-[(1R,3S)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl]-5-(2-methyloctan-2-yl) phenol.
- (3) HU-210:[(6xR, 10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6, 6-dimethyl-3-(1, 1-dimethylheptyl)-6a,7,10,10a-tetrahydro-1-hydroxy-6,6-dimethyl-6H-dibenzo[b,d]pyran-9-methanol.
- (4) JWH-018: 1-pentyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, also known as Naphthalen 1-yl(1-pentylindol-3-yl)methanone.
- (5) JWH-073): 1-butyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, also known as Naphthalen-1-yl-(1-butylindol-3-yl)methanone.
- (6) JWH-081: 1-pentyl-3-(4-methoxy-1-naphthoyl)indole, also known as 4-methoxynaphthalen-1-yl-(1-pentylindol-3-yl) methanone.
- (7) JWH-220: 1-[2-(4-morpholinyl)ethyl]-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole.
- (8) JWH-250: 1-pentyl-3-(2-methoxyphenylacetyl)indole, also known as 2-(2-methoxyphenyl)-1-(1-pentylindol-3-yl)ethanone.

1.02 Unlawful Possession of Synthetic Substances. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or attempt to possess a substance containing a synthetic cannabinoid.

1.03 Penalty. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof shall forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$500 plus the costs of prosecution and in default of

provisions of this Ordinance are severable.


1.06 Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication
