

ORDINANCE NO. 012-2000-35

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HIGHER FEES FOR ASHLAND COUNTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, pursuant to §814.70, Wisconsin Statutes, the Sheriff shall collect the fees provided for in such section unless a higher fee is established by the County Board under §814.705, Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the fees for service of process and for execution on a judgment which are set forth in §814.70, Wisconsin Statutes, are low compared with the Sheriff's costs for performing such services, and such fees are lower than what most other counties are charging, and it appropriate that the County Board establish higher fees for such services,

NOW, THEREFORE,

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Ashland does ordain as follows:

Effective upon publication, the Sheriff of Ashland County shall collect the following fees:

1. The fee for service of process enumerated in §814.70(1), Wisconsin Statutes, is increased from \$12.00 to \$25.00.
2. The fee for serving an execution on a judgment enumerated in §814.70(2), Wisconsin Statutes, is increased from \$12.00 to \$25.00.

Except as specifically set forth herein, the other fees of sheriffs provided for in §814.70, Wisconsin Statutes, shall be as provided for therein.

This ordinance is adopted as per §814.705(1), Wisconsin Statutes.
