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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 5.1 AND 5.3
OF THE ASHLAND COUNTY SHORELAND/AMENDATORY ORDINANCE
ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 10, 1985

WHEREAS, after the Zoning Committee of the Board of Supervisors of Ashland County approved proposed amendments to Sections 5.1 and 5.3 of the Ashland County Shoreland/Amendatory Ordinance adopted September 10, 1985, it called a public hearing thereon to be held on April 17, 1991, at 9:30 a.m. at the Ashland County Board Room at the Ashland County Courthouse, Ashland, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, a March 12, 1991, Notice of such public hearing was published in the Daily Press Newspaper in Ashland, Wisconsin, as a Class 2 Notice under Chapter 985, Wisconsin Statutes, on March 22, 1991, and March 29, 1991, and a copy of such Notice was mailed by Registered Mail to the Town Clerk of each town in Ashland County at least ten (10) days prior to the date of such hearing, and the return receipt cards Ashland County received back from the town clerks indicate that all towns in Ashland County received such notice of public hearing on or before April 2, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the County Zoning Agency did not receive any resolution, notice or other document from any town board disapproving of such proposed amendment or providing for an extension of time to disapprove of such proposed amendments; and

WHEREAS, after the April 17, 1991, public hearing on such proposed amendment was held, the Zoning Committee of the Board of Supervisors of Ashland County modified and then approved the proposed amendments which are set forth below and cause this Ordinance to be drafted effectuating its determination and filed its report with the Board of Supervisors of Ashland County,

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ASHLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sections 5.1 and 5.3 of the Ashland County Shoreland/Amendatory Ordinance adopted September 10, 1985, are hereby amended to provide as follows:

- 5.1 All permanent structures except legally erected piers shall be set back a minimum distance of 75 feet from the ordinary high water mark of any navigable water.
- 5.3 Boathouses. The use of boathouses for habitation is prohibited. Boat houses shall be designed solely for the storage of boats and related equipment. All boathouses shall be set back a minimum of 75 feet from the ordinary high water mark of any navigable water. ~~Reduced setbacks for boathouses shall be permitted pursuant to Section 5.2.~~ Legally erected accessory buildings may be used to reduce such setbacks for boathouses. Nonconforming boathouses shall be governed by Section 10 of this ordinance.

Pursuant to §59.09(1), Wis. Stats., the County Clerk shall immediately publish this Ordinance as a Class 1 Notice under Chapter 985 and shall procure and distribute copies of such paper to the various town clerks, who shall file the same in their respective offices.
