- All Ashland County Forest bid requirements apply to this sale. Ashland County Forest will be overseeing the bidding, harvesting and billing of this timber sale.
- Bid bond / performance bond should be made payable to Ashland County Forest. Bib bonds in the form of company or personal checks will not be accepted.



CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

In the thinning sale area cut all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen and balsam fir with 1 or more 100" pulp sticks. Cut all ironwood 1" DBH and greater.
 - All other trees must remain uncut and undamaged.


Do not cut snags. Utilize all felled trees to a 4" minimum top diameter for pulpwood and a 10" minimum top diameter for saw logs.

- Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in the suspension of logging.
- The sale must be cut progressively.
- No new woods road shall be constructed without prior approval of the county forester.
- Care must be taken to preserve survey monuments.
- Care must be taken to not excessively damage existing saplings.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:


- In the coppice sale area cut all trees 1" DBH or greater except hemlock, oak, cedar, and pine. Do not cut dead trees, do not cut hollow trees.
- Do not operate outside the sale boundaries. A 100' RMZ is marked along the creek in red paint.
- Do not cut snags. Utilize all felled trees to a 4" minimum top diameter for pulpwood and a 10" minimum top diameter for saw logs.

CUTTING RESTRICTIONS:

- Sale access through Bohon Property. Access has been secured
- No road work may start until meeting with forester or landowner has occurred to discuss expectations.
- Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in the suspension of logging.
- The sale must be cut progressively.
- No new woods road shall be constructed without prior approval of the county forester.
- Care must be taken to preserve survey monuments.
- Care must be taken to not excessively damage existing saplings.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

- In the thinning sale area cut all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen, jack pine and balsam fir with 1 or more 100" pulp sticks.
 - In the group selection cut all trees marked with orange paint and all merchantable aspen and balsam fir.
 - In the overstory removal cut all merchantable trees except trees marked in green paint, oak, pine, hemlock, cedar. Care must be used to minimize damage to existing saplings.
- Do not cut snags. Utilize all felled trees to a 4" minimum top diameter for pulpwood and a 10" minimum top diameter for saw logs.



- No new woods road shall be constructed without prior approval of the county forester.

- Care must be taken to not excessively damage existing saplings.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

- In the hardwood selection sale area cut all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen and balsam fir with 1 or more 100" pulp sticks. Cut all ironwood 1" DBH and greater.
- All other trees must remain uncut and undamaged.
- Do not cut snags. Utilize all felled trees to a 4" minimum top diameter for pulpwood and a 10" minimum top diameter for saw logs.


